1921 Ford Model T Coup

This is a rare example of a preserved 1921 Model T Coup. This car is a survivor, it has never been restored.

Model Ts were built between 1909 and 1927. This is an exceptional example of a 102 year old car.

It has a coach-built body, meaning that it has an all-wood structure with the sheet metal attached to a wooden frame. Most of these coach-built bodies deteriorated when the roof leaked causing wood rot. The doors would then not close properly and the car was usually abandoned and left to decay.

The roof on this car has been replaced to prevent this from happening. It has been stored inside for most of its life. We understand that it was owned by a pilot for much of its life and was stored in a hanger. Most of the interior is original.

It has been painted with a brush in its lifetime.

- The engine is 177 cu in. 20 HP flathead.
- Transmission is a 3 pedal/2 speed planetary
- 30-31/2 clincher wheels and tires.

This car is a driver and has toured throughout Alberta over the 20 years that I have owned it.
